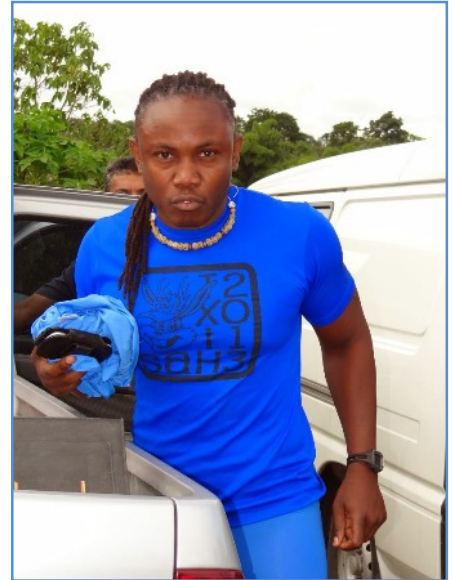

Head north on Saddle. At the North coast road Junction (Road to Maracas), continue straight on Saddle Road into Santa Cruz. Continue along Saddle Road, past Saddle Grove, Cutucupano Road and Santa Cruz Market and then to Santa Cruz Food Basket. Here veer right to stay on Saddle Road. Continue along Saddle Road passing Santa Cruz Police Station and Santa Cruz Fire Station. About 400 meters past the Fire Station, turn left onto La Sagesse Road.

Continue along La Sagesse Road passing Santa Barbara Blvd Extension on right, until you reach El Carmen Road. Turn right onto El Carmen Road and take an immediate left onto Gasparillo Road (Blue Round House here) and continue along this road to the run site.

From San Juan:

Continue along Saddle Road until you reach La Sagesse Road and follow directions above!
